WHEN: Land package dates: Thursday, September 29/2011 until Monday, October 3/2011.

WHERE: Munich, Germany

WHO: Oldtimer's ice hockey teams from North America and Europe.

WHAT HOCKEY: Minimum 3 games guaranteed.

FREE SPOTS: All Group leaders receive 1 FREE land package per team with a minimum 15 players/ travelers in your group. (Free spot in double occupancy)

PLAYER LAND PACKAGE PRICING:

\$1299.00 CDN plus GST per person in double occupancy including all other taxes and gratuities.

COMPANION PRICING:

\$1149.00 CDN plus GST per person in double occupancy including all other taxes and gratuities.

PAYMENT PLAN:

On booking: \$300.00 non-refundable deposit per person.

April 15th/2011: \$300.00 payment per person is due.

June 15th/2011: \$300.00 payment per person is due.

August 15th/2011: Remaining balance is due.

2011 OLDTIMER'S @ OKTOBERFEST FAQ

LAND PACKAGE AND FLIGHTS:

Do we need to book the 4-day Land Package?

Yes, this is a mandatory part of registration into the tournament.

Can we book our own flights or use Air Miles?

Yes to both questions. THTC is a full service travel agency so we can book flights for you but it is not a mandatory part of tournament registration.

Can we extend our visit and travel to other countries?

Yes. See above. Participants must book the 4-day tournament land package but are free to travel early to Europe or stay longer after the tournament.

What is the difference between group flights and individual tickets?

With most airlines, you need a minimum of 15 people to book group flights. Group contracts usually don't offer better pricing than individual tickets but rather better conditions. With group contracts, you only need to provide names 60 days prior to departure and you don't need to pay in full at the time of booking; two distinct advantages when dealing with hockey teams. What quality are the hotel rooms?

Motel One Munich South is a mid level Hotel. Similar quality as some large chain hotels in North America like Holiday Inn, Ramada, Best Western etc. However, sometimes the amenities (very few hotels have swimming pools etc) and the bed configurations are slightly different.

Motel One Munich South is located in the area of "Giesing" in Munich South.

Approximate distances to hotel:

- Streetcar (Tegernseer Landstraße) 300m,
- Subway stop Wettersteinplatz 400m
- Subway stop Silberhornstraße 750m
- Munich Main walking district (Marienplatz) 4km
- Munich Main Train Station 5 km
- Munich Airport 38 km
- Germering Polarium (Tournament arena) 21km

What size are the rooms?

In general, the rooms are smaller than a typical N.A. hotel room.

Do they have air conditioning?

Yes.....however, in certain hotels in Mainland Europe, the AC is not up to N.A. standards.

How many people can stay in a room?

All rooms are double occupancy. Double rooms usually have 2 twin beds. Single supplement on request only.

What types of buses do we use?

Full service coach bus with washroom, T.V., VCR or DVD etc.

Do we have the use of the bus the whole day?

No. Bus service will be indicated in our final itinerary. Please see our sample itinerary.

How do we get around on our own?

Hotel is situated in the south section of downtown. Some distances are too far to walk but are easily accessible by Street car, subway or taxi. All of these options are relatively inexpensive. Please see our "Approximate distances to hotel" and our sample itinerary.



HOCKEY:

What divisions/age groups will you have?

We will be building divisions/age groups based on team registration.

Our tentative plan is to have one Over 35/40 division and one Over 50/55 division.

How many games?

3-game guarantee. Format to be decided.

Is this is a competitive tournament or a fun, social tournament?

Naturally, teams will still want to win but the focus is as a fun, social event with the built in atmosphere of Oktoberfest as a backdrop.

THTC would like to stick to the motto "Experience Life through Sport" and so overzealous play, fighting etc won't be tolerated.

MONEY:

Can we use credit cards while in Munich?

YES...normally all major cards are accepted.

Can we use our bank card?

YES...but you have to find an affiliate bank (within the "PLUS" system or "EURO CARD" system). This is the easiest way to deal with the different currencies.

Should I bring traveller's cheques?

Some people feel more comfortable with traveller's cheques (In Euros is easiest) but with the ease of use of bank cards, they are not necessary.



INSURANCE:

What travel insurance is included?

There is **no** travel insurance included in your 4-day package.

Travellers should check what other coverage they have through work or other private companies and then decide if they would like to purchase RBC travel insurance through THTC or waive this option.

Are players covered during hockey games if they purchase RBC Travel Insurance?

RBC Medical coverage does include amateur sports coverage but individuals should read their policy to clarify all the exclusions and to make certain they have adequate coverage.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

Do I only need a passport?

Currently for North American passport holders travelling to Germany only a passport is required, but we do suggest that every individual look into their own personal situation (landed immigrant etc.) with their respective embassy/consulate prior to travelling.

SIGHTSEEING:

How much sightseeing will be planned for us?

There is no additional sightseeing included (other than Oktoberfest) included in your 4-day land package. However, we can arrange add-ons for your group if requested. Some sample add-ons are:

- Munich City Tour
- Dachau Concentration Camp
- Bayern Munich Soccer Game
- Tour to the Alps south of Munich

THE HANLON TOUR COMPANY (THTC) TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The purchase of these travel services constitutes a contractual agreement. In making any reservation through THTC you accept and agree to be bound by these conditions. Therefore, please make sure you have read and clearly understand these terms and conditions before making your reservation.

PAYMENT—\$300.00 non-refundable deposit due upon acceptance of travel package with air. The final balance is due 60 days before departure. \$150.00 non-refundable deposit due upon acceptance of “land only” travel package. The final balance is due 30 days before departure.

PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD—We do not accept credit cards for group travel.

FINAL BALANCE—Failure to pay your group’s final balance on time renders the tour liable to cancellation by Team Tours International.

CANCELLATION—The following charges will apply in the event of any cancellation:

For Packages with air:

- 60 days or more prior to departure date: Non-refundable Deposit
- 30 to 59 days prior to departure date: 65% of total package cost including taxes and service charges, per person
- 30 days or less prior to departure date: 100% of total package cost, including taxes and service charges, per person

For Land Only Packages:

- 30 days or more prior to departure date: Non-refundable Deposit
- 15 to 30 days prior to departure date: 50% of total package per person
- Less than 15 days prior to departure date : 100% of total package per person

SUPPLEMENTAL CHARGES—Individuals are responsible for ALL charges not included in your THTC travel package. These include, but are not limited to, hotel incidentals for mini-bar, movies, telephone, gas for rental vehicles or any other charge not outlined in your tour package.

FUEL SURCHARGES—Individuals are responsible for any fuel surcharges charged by the airline. Individuals will pay the applicable airline taxes owing at the time of ticket issuance (this can vary from the group price quoted at booking).

ROOM ALLOCATION—Hoteliers are solely responsible for room allocation, in accordance with the category reserved by consumers. Should customers choose to alter their room category upon arrival at destination (upon availability), they must make their own arrangements with the hotelier and assume all additional fees levied by them. Special requests concerning room amenities and location can be transmitted to the hotelier. These requests do not constitute on any account a confirmation.



CONNECTING FLIGHTS—Whenever customers book connecting flights, they must allow sufficient time to make the connection. No control can be exercised over airline carriers to guarantee flight schedules, which may be altered or affected by various circumstances. All connecting flight reservations are made at the risk of the customer, who hereby agrees to assume the cost of any loss in the event of a change to the original flight schedule. THTC cannot be held liable for damages or additional fees incurred by customers owing to a missed flight connection, whatever the reason.

Liability: The provisions of the Warsaw Convention, as well as the notice appearing on the passenger ticket and baggage check, govern the loss of and damage to baggage and establish the limits of carrier liability. At all other times, baggage is transported at the risk of consumers.

Airport check-in: It is mandatory that customers arrive at the airport check-in counter at least two (2) hours prior to departure, failing which their reservation may be **cancelled** and their seats may be assigned to other customers, with no right of recourse.

DEVIATIONS—Supplements are payable for individuals wishing to vary or modify their tour dates from those of the main group. The airlines' deviations fees vary depending on the number and extent of the deviations. Total number of deviations is strictly limited.

CUSTOMER CHANGES—Absolutely **no** changes will be made **after** the final balance (full payment) has been received unless otherwise allowed by supplier, paid for by customer and there is a reasonable amount of time to implement the change.

CHANGES TO TRAVEL SERVICES—If confirmed goods or services are no longer available prior to the departure date or subsequent to arrival at destination, THTC reserves the right to substitute them for comparable goods or services, or to cancel them in the case of default. If the substituted goods or services are of lesser value, the liability of THTC shall be limited to the sole difference in cost. If the substituted goods or services are of greater value, the customer will be required to disburse an amount equal to the difference between the original prices and the substituted goods or services. The customer will be entitled to refuse such substitutions, in such a case, and in the event of a cancellation, liability of THTC shall be limited to the reimbursement of the price of goods or services paid by the customer.

SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES—THTC cannot be held responsible for any accident or mishap occurring at the destination during the practice of any sport and/or activity in which the customers participate of their own free will and initiative. Please see "Travel Insurance".

RESPONSIBILITY—THTC. Takes great pride in its selection of vendors. However, THTC and its' employees function as an intermediary and/or agent for independent contractors who provide air and ground transportation, hotel accommodation, leisure activities and other services offered as part of the THTC travel packages. THTC. Shall also have the right to use agents to assist and provide the services ordered by the Customer.

THTC nor any of its intermediaries, are agents for transportation carriers, hotels or providers of the services offered as part of the THTC travel packages and at all times. Consequently, THTC such shall not be held responsible or liable for any losses or breaches of contract or any omissions or careless actions by the suppliers that may result in any damage, loss, injury, delay or irregularity.





By acceptance hereof, individual or team members acknowledge that THTC and its' employees shall not be liable for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay, irregularity or expense incurred by participants due to act or default of any independent contractor(s) or supplier(s). Customer voluntarily assumes all risks and is advised to obtain insurance, other than the insurance provided, if so needed.

The Customer agrees to indemnify THTC, its officers, employees and servants from liability for any injury, loss or damage arising in the course of transportation or any other ancillary services provided by THTC pursuant to the sale made by THTC hereunder or arising from the failure of THTC to provide transportation or services.

Further, THTC accepts no responsibility for any sickness, pilferage, labor disputes, machinery breakdowns, government restraints, weather conditions or any misadventure or casualty of any other cause beyond its' control.

VALIDITY OF TICKETS—Tickets are made out in the name of the customer and are not transferable. Tickets are valid only on the dates and flights indicated. Unused portions of tickets may not be used for travel on other flights and are not subject to refund at any time.

TRAVEL INSURANCE—THTC offers Travel Insurance to all THTC travelers as a measure of added consumer protection. If customers decide to decline coverage, they should purchase travel insurance elsewhere or confirm any other personal coverage they might have before departure. For information and details about the travel insurance plan best suited to their needs, consumers are advised to consult with their THTC travel coordinator.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS—All travelers are responsible to bring a valid passport and any other required identification. It is the full responsibility and expense of customers to obtain all documents required by all relevant government authorities. Canadian citizens must show proof of citizenship (birth certificate or citizenship card) and official identity card with picture for destinations where passports or visas are not required. One (1) parent traveling with a child must obtain an affidavit signed by the other parent authorizing the child to travel. Customers must check with THTC to find out which documents are required, and then make certain that they have the documents in hand prior to departure. No refund or replacement will be given for lost or stolen travel documents, denied access to the country of origin or denied access by a carrier or any other relevant authority.

COMMENTS AND COMPLAINTS—At destination, customers must contact the THTC representative or the hotel director immediately to get his/her assistance and to remedy any problem without delay, whenever such a problem can be reasonably remedied. In the event that a problem cannot be solved or dealt with immediately, customers are requested to forward the specifics of the incident in writing to THTC within thirty (30) days or failing which no action will be taken.

JURISDICTION—This agreement is governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the laws of Canada, as applicable. You irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts and legal system of that province and country.

All transportation sold under this agreement by the Agent or by its officers, employees, or servants shall be sold subject to the conditions of carriage of the carriers concerned applicable to the transportation.
